The Analyst will work closely with the investment team to structure and execute new investments. The Analyst will also be responsible for post-investment monitoring and asset valuation activities for portfolio investments.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design and develop complex financial models to facilitate valuation analysis necessary for the evaluation of investment opportunities.
- Work closely with senior members of the investment team to conduct due diligence and support the execution of new investments.
- Create detailed investment presentations and memoranda for presentation to investment committee articulating transaction overviews, key investment highlights and risks, etc.
- Review investment portfolio performance and assist the asset management team in reporting and creating analysis and presentation of results for investors, lenders and senior management, including creation of quarterly valuation reports for specific investments.
- Analyze the financial impact of equity raises, re-financings, and debt offerings.
- Refine, enhance, and implement financial reporting tools and systems.
